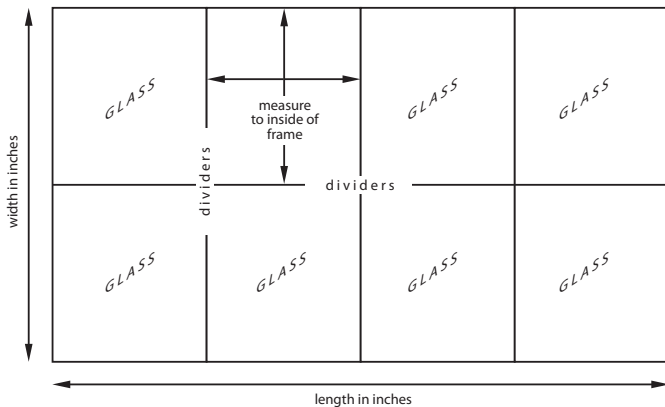

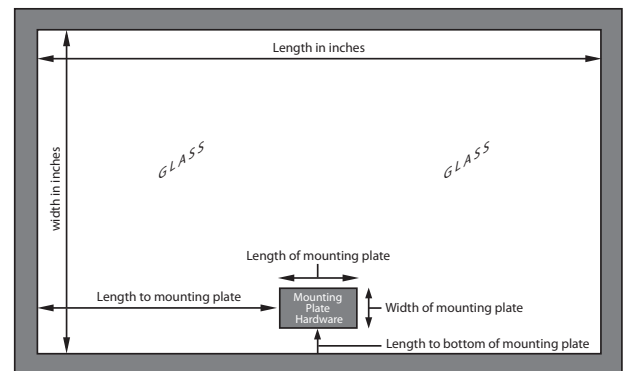


HOW TO MEASURE YOUR TROPHY CASE/WINDOW OR DOOR GLASS.

- Measure from the FRONT side of the Trophy Case/Window or Door Glass.
- Measure the length and width of each glass panel that is separated by a frame from the inside of frame to inside of frame. (see diagram).

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR BACKBOARD GLASS.

- Measure glass from the BACK side of the board.
- Measure the overall width and length of the glass **from the inside edge of the frame.**

COST

Prior to 2008, the price per backboard installation was \$450. Today, the average GRS kit is \$199. Because trophy cases and backboards vary in size, Clear Defense provides custom estimates; however \$9/sq.ft. is an average cost.
