

# **NIAAA ENDOWMENT** **STATE ASSOCIATION GRANT APPLICATION**

## **PHILOSOPHY:**

As part of the NIAAA's Outreach Program, to use a portion of the funds accrued interest from the NIAAA Endowment Fund for the professional development of NIAAA members

## **GOAL OF GRANT PROGRAM:**

To assist state athletic administrator associations by providing funds for professional development. State athletic administrator associations may apply for the funds to use for the following:

- 1) Assist in bringing qualified LTC instructors to state athletic administrator conference
- 2) Assist in bringing a keynote or other speaker to state athletic administrator conference
- 3) Assist in paying for an instructor's/speaker's stipend, transportation or lodging

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Grant requests will be reviewed by the NIAAA Board of Directors and selected by the same.
- Grant applications may be requested at any time of year.
- Up to **\$15,000** in total grant money may be given out between the dates of July 1 to June 30 of any given fiscal year by the board of directors.
- The maximum amount given per grant application will be **\$1,000** and all funds requested must be used within one year.
- **A state athletic administrator association may apply for a grant only once every three years.**
- When the total allocation of **\$15,000** is awarded, no additional money will be awarded in that fiscal year.
- Any grant money that is not awarded in a given fiscal year will not carry over to the next fiscal year.
